After high school, Bill attended Oklahoma State University for one year. Bill served his country in the Navy for two years during the Korean War. ## VOTING RIGHTS by Ruthie Rogers

**Uriah Harting** served during the Civil War in the Pennsylvania Infantry. His wife, **Evannah Benner Harting**, worried about the safety of their children, brought them to Sterling, IL by covered wagon in the 1860's.

One of Uriah and Evannah's children, **Maryanne Harting** married **Jacob R. Fry**. They in turn had a daughter, **Evanna Fry** who was born on Jan. 21, 1873. She married **Robert E. Drane**, an Englishman, on Oct. 30, 1890. Evan and Robert had ten children, the youngest of whom was my mother, **Ruth Evelyn Drane**. She married **Edgar Rogers**.

My mother told me about the Women Suffrage Act that gave women the right to vote. My grandmother, **Evanna Fry Drane**,

and her oldest child, **Mary Drane**, registered to vote. Election Day came and they both went to vote. Mary was allowed to vote but Evanna was denied the right to vote, solely on the basis of her marriage to the Englishman, **Robert Drane**.

As a matter of fact, this also happened to a movie star who had married an Englishman. Her notoriety gave clout to her outcry against the injustice of her denial of voting rights. Congress rectified this injustice and their voting rights were restored. However, when the next election came, Evanna's health had declined and she was never able to vote.

My mother, **Ruth Rogers**, never failed to emphasize to me the importance of voting, especially because of what had happened to her mother. I have consistently carried out her advice.

Now, two generations later, Evannah's granddaughter, **Ruthie E. Rogers**, holds an elective office. I am the township highway commissioner in Rock Falls, IL.
